We hope to be able to share with you in the next few days the possible impact of full / partial school closure so that parents and carers can plan accordingly.

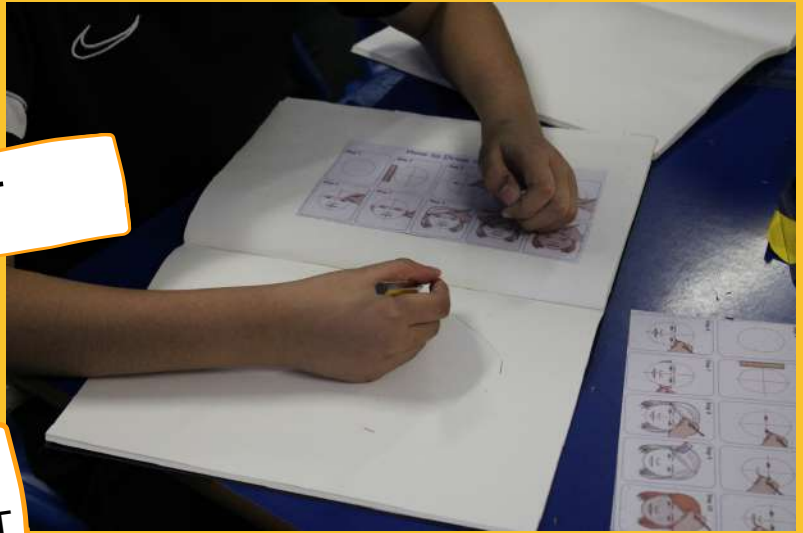

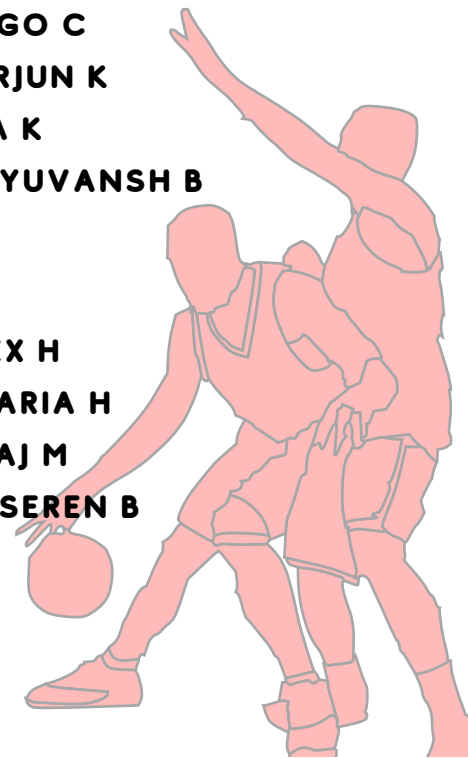

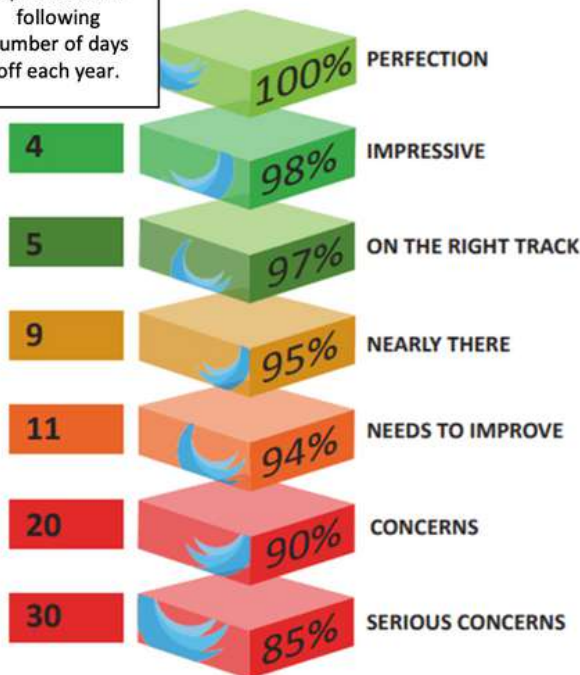
