Golf

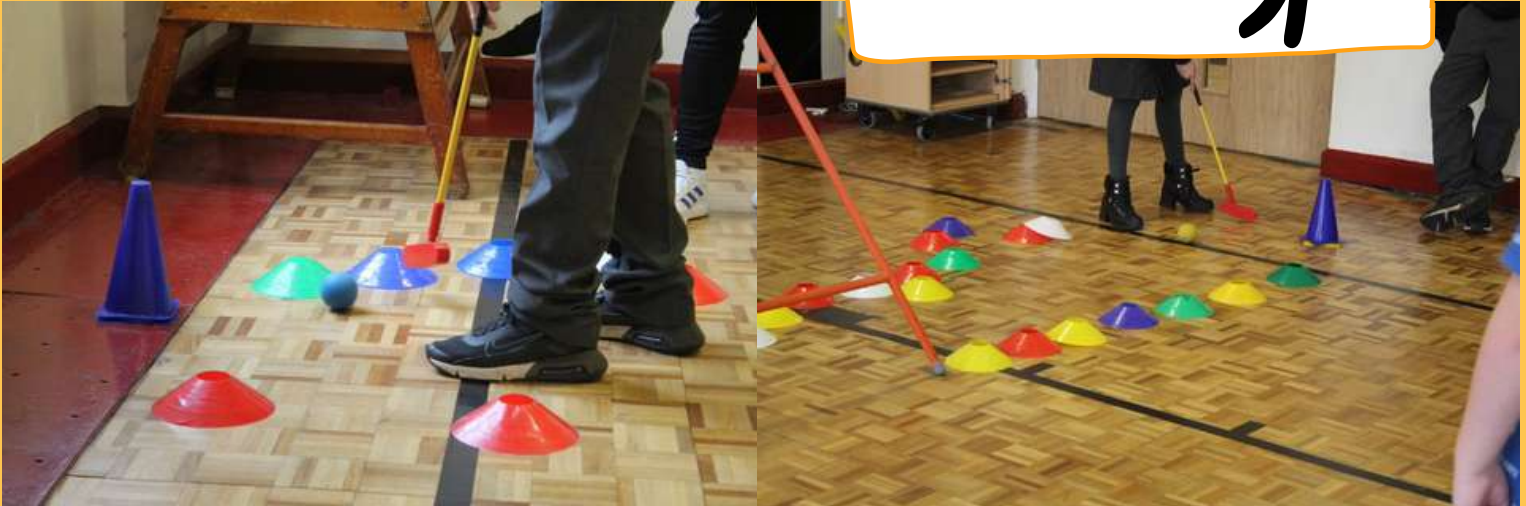

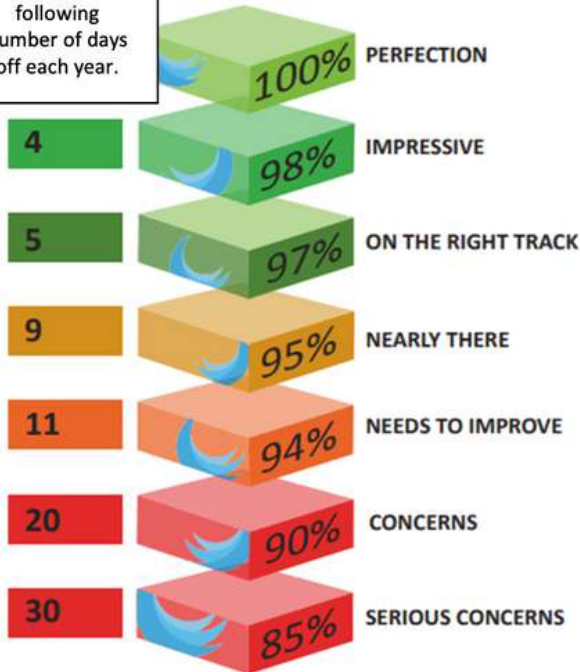
